While we are still figuring out this “new normal”, we are feeling blessed to live in a community that knows how to work together when it is needed most.

Active as a coach, both Wild's were strong advocates of the benefits of the Cass County YMCA and would encourage youth to participate. When kids have told him they have nothing to do, he's suggested the YMCA, but often they've said they're not sure they can afford it. That made Wild think, "Maybe I can do something about that," he said. As he contemplated how best to encourage youth to become YMCA members, he decided to establish a fund to provide financial support to youth who could not otherwise afford a membership. Wild hopes the fund, named after both he and his late wife Karen, will serve as an inspiration to others to help local youth get involved in healthy activities.

4TH DIMENSION RECOVERY HOMES

During early 2019, we were introduced to a new group, 4th Dimension Recovery Homes, who were working to become a new non-profit in Cass County to serve those individuals seeking stability after treatment for substance abuse. What started as a brief

offer of assistance for help in creating their governing documents has grown into a larger commitment for CCCF. As part of our work through Lilly Endowment's GIFT Phase VII, we had the opportunity to submit an implementation grant proposal to Lilly Endowment Inc. and received \$100,000 to be used to help purchase a property for the home.

We have continued to be a mentor to the group as they learn best practices for being a successful non-profit and our President, Deanna Crispen, serves on their advisory board.

Our support has included hosting and leading a "Board Retreat" which was extremely successful as they left with a clear vision, a focused mission and set of values to build their nonprofit around. We also provide financial support for their Addiction Awareness Day, Faces of Recovery event and most importantly, we are leading the search for an appropriate property to establish a recovery home in Cass County until that property is found the group meets in the CCCF board room.

FIGHTING HUNGER DURING A PANDEMIC

As a community, we were all pulling together to keep food in the hands of those who were in need but over time, it became apparent that many of our residents, even with the support of our food pantries, could use a little more help. The question was how to get the food into those hands that needed it most?

A phone call from Iron Horse Radio's Allan James was all it took to find that pathway. James' idea, WIN IT TO GIVE IT was simple. Listeners could call in at specific times and win a \$50 Martins Grocery Gift Card. The only stipulation was that if the winner did not need the help, they would give it to a friend or neighbor who did need help.

With the help of the local radio stations, we were able to place \$50 Martins Grocery Gift Cards totaling \$10,200



into the hands of local people during the first two weeks of May through "WIN IT TO GIVE IT". The program was so successful that later in the year, the program was awarded the Indiana Broadcasters Association's coveted Cardinal Community Service Award.

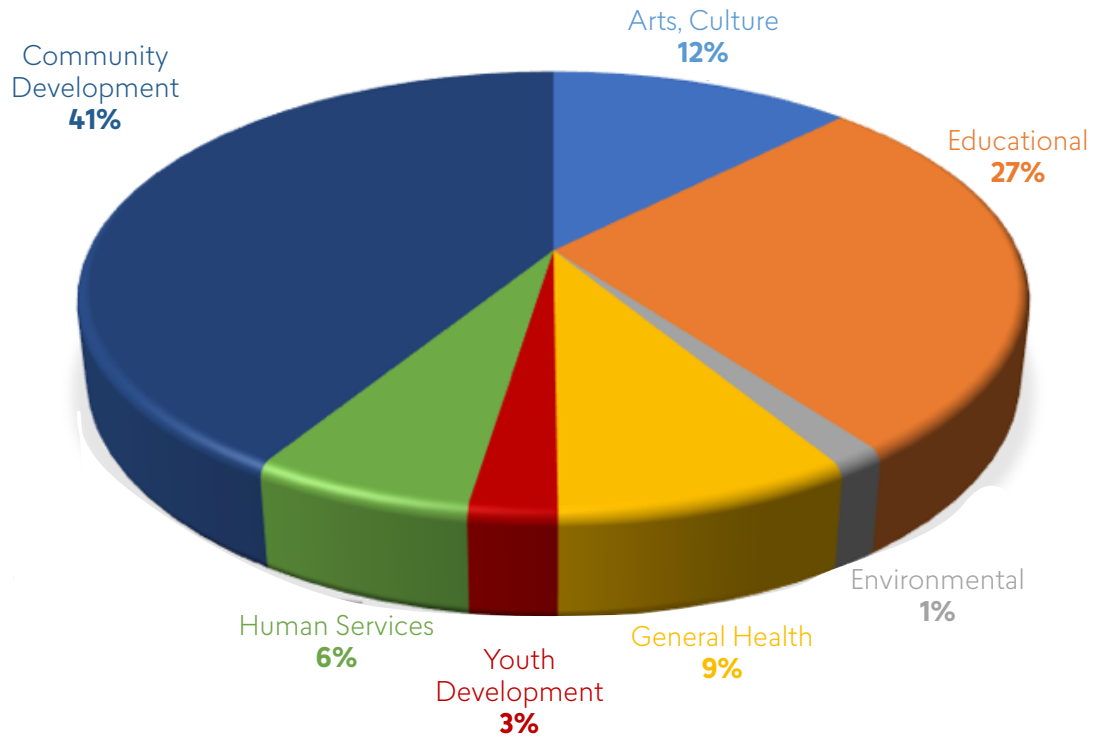

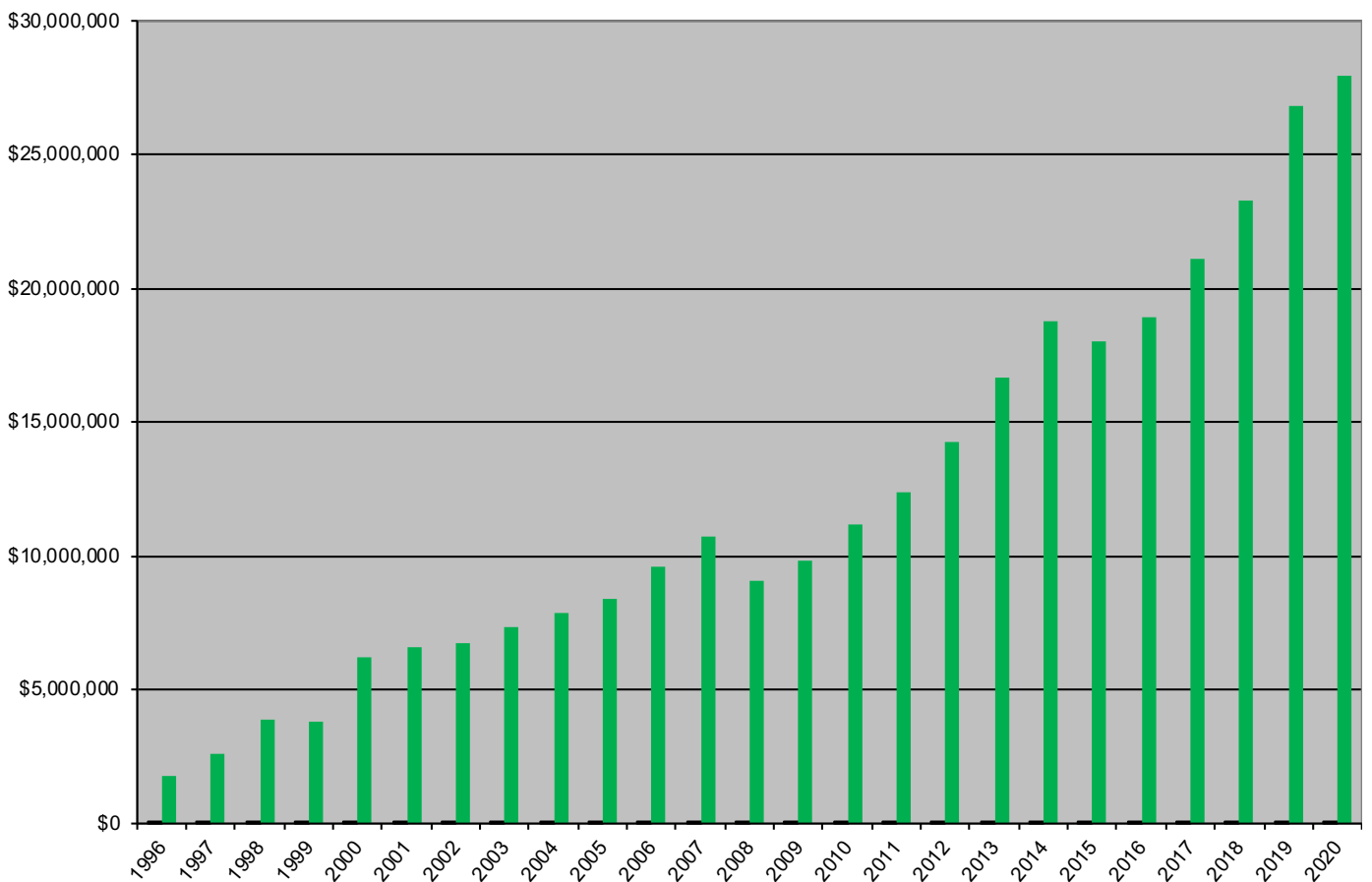

member the opportunity to make a \$2,000 grant to a charitable organization.

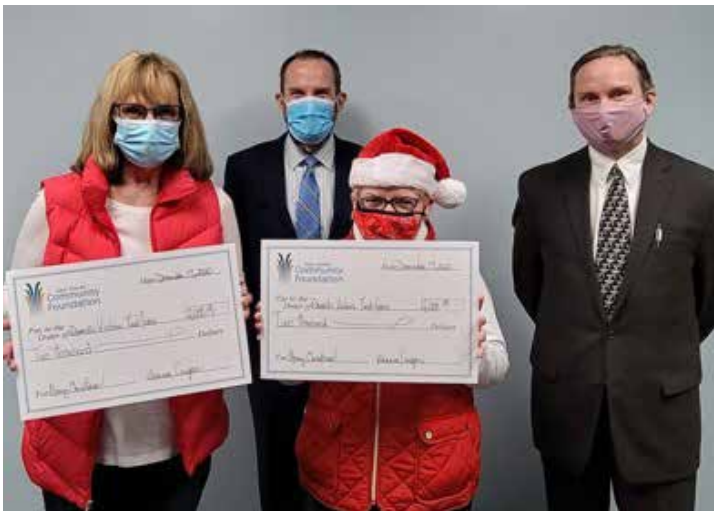
- Giving neighbors a chance to help each other through gifting grocery gift cards from D & R and Martins.

Our board members truly enjoyed being a Santa to eleven different nonprofits. The surprise visits and the \$30,000 in emergency grants were a perfect way to share the holiday with our community.

He is the son of Grant and Teresa Montgomery. His plans include attending Taylor University to pursue a bachelor's degree in Biology Science Education followed by a masters at Purdue University with the ultimate goal of returning to the community and pursuing a high school teaching career in advanced sciences and coaching.

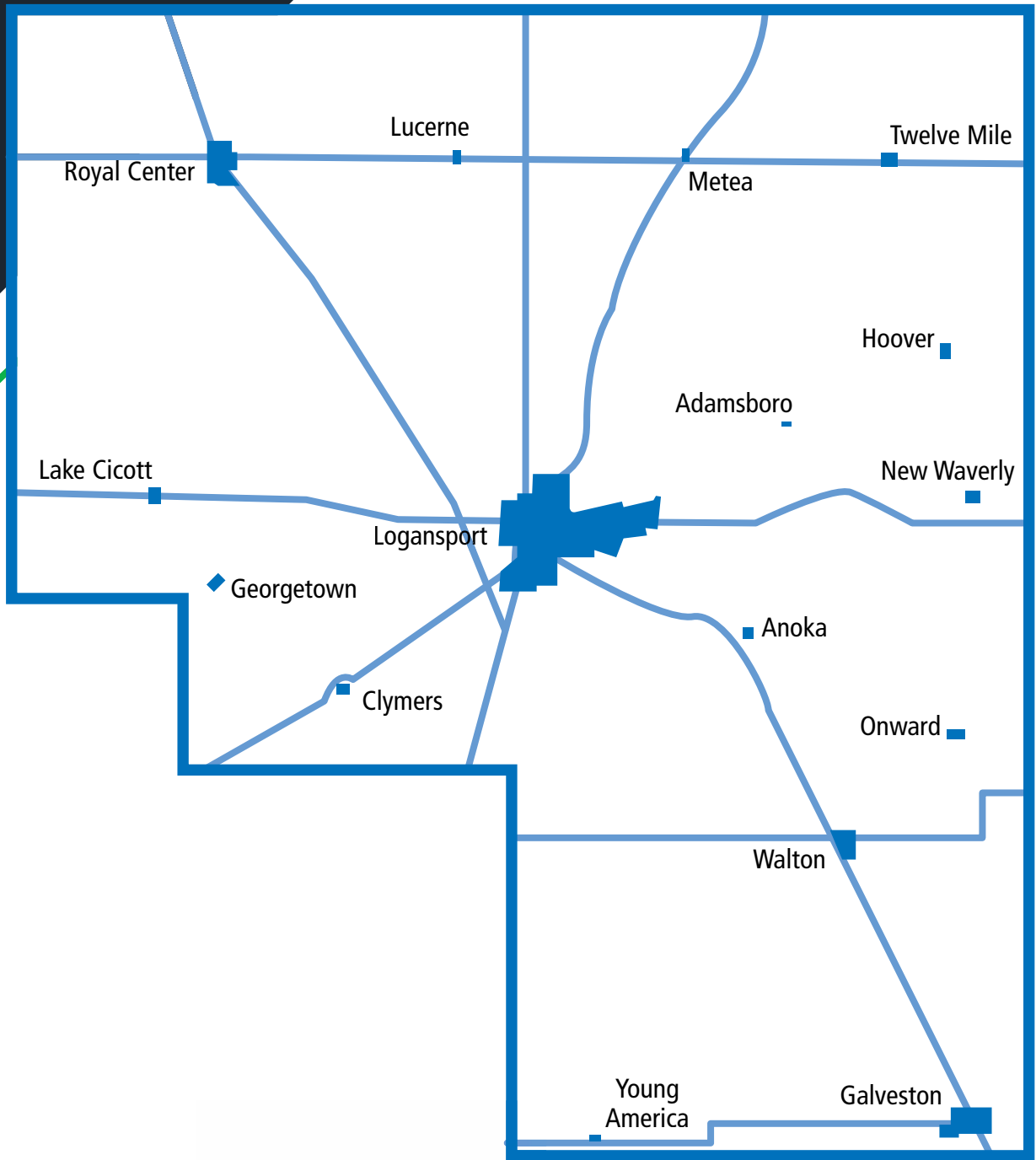
