LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT

**R**ebounding can mean a lot of things depending on the situation and what you are doing. It can be a great statistic for a basketball star, it can mean you are in limbo from a previous relationship, it can even mean you are getting well from a serious illness. So, what does using the word “rebounding” mean regarding 2021? Rebounding for Cass County was all about heart and our ability to bounce back after tremendous loss and uncertainty of 2020.

The pandemic and shutdown of life as we know it in 2020 left many of our nonprofits struggling to stay afloat and provide services during the shutdown and subsequent slow reopening. Many organizations had few or no opportunities to fundraise and yet were called upon to serve a growing population in need. The CCCF Board of Directors remained focused on the good of the community, never faltered, and were quick to step up and provide additional funding to our local organizations. The impact of their

actions led the Board to set a new record and awarded \$205,647.50 to fund community grant projects and combined with designated gifts and scholarships awarded close to \$1,000,000 in 2021.



Our community in 2021 took the hard lessons we learned during the covid pandemic in 2020 about teamwork, collaboration, and the power we possess when we work together to greater success. The powerful sense of community spirit and looking out for our neighbors led to continuing conversations supporting education, recovery, and helping our nonprofits be more effective. We were also blessed with the ongoing support of many community donors and ended 2021 with \$32.5 million in assets to benefit Cass County-For Good. For Ever.

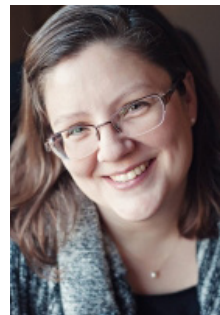

# FIRST EVER ELIZABETH A. BILLMAN EXCELLENCE IN TEACHING AWARD TO JENNIFER ROSENBERGER

The Elizabeth A. Billman Excellence in Teaching Award was established by the CCCF Board of Directors to honor Billman who had served faithfully on the Board of Directors of the Cass County Community Foundation for a period of 16 years, serving two terms as Chairman of the Board of Directors and was on the Board of Directors at the time of her passing.

Mrs. Billman retired as principal at Thompson Elementary School and also taught in the Southeastern School Corporation, beginning her teaching career at Washington Township School, and retiring with over 38 years of service to the Southeastern School Corporation. She was a member of the Lewis Cass Alumni Association where she received the Distinguished Service Award.

Jennifer Rosenberger was named as the recipient of the first "Elizabeth A. Billman Excellence in Teaching Award" during the end of school year awards at Franklin Elementary School. Rosenberger was selected for the award from a pool of nominees submitted by elementary building principals of grades K-6 from all county schools, who most exemplify Elizabeth's commitment to the students under her care, as well as embodies her thirst



for knowledge, learning, and commitment to community service.

Deanna Crispen, CCCF President & CEO and Lisa Swaim, Board Chairman made the announcement and commended Rosenberger for her devotion to her students, colleagues, professional development, and community. Crispen said, "Elizabeth Billman was an educator, administrator, mentor and role model for young women and teachers. When we thought about ways to honor her legacy, this award, to encourage teachers early in their careers, was the result and we know Liz would be proud we are continuing her legacy through the award."

Rosenberger who teaches second grade at Franklin was nominated by her principal,

Mr. Michael Miller who said of her, "one of her strongest attributes is her devotion to her students." His nomination shared that Jennifer has students with incredibly diverse needs, yet she does not allow the bar to be lowered for her second graders, instead challenging the students to rise and they leave her classroom in May devoted to her. He said, "one fourth grader inquired if she could visit Ms. Rosenberger in the morning, "because nobody loves me like she did"- expressing that Jennifer was the first teacher who made her believe in herself."

The award consists of a \$500 stipend for the teacher and a commemorative plaque. A permanent plaque has been designed will be located at the CCCF Office to honor each year's recipient.



## NEW FUND TO SUPPORT CASS COUNTY HONOR GUARD

During the last several years, we have been privileged to work with the Cass County Honor Guard volunteers and more importantly to witness their service at funerals for our veterans. Their words and their actions during these tough times remind us all of the true sacrifices our veterans have made and offers comfort to the families.

The Cass County Honor Guard is a group of veteran volunteers who offer a special memorial rite at the funeral services of

Cass County Veterans. The Honor Guard typically serves between 70 to 100 families per year, with 9 to 12 members participating in the solemn rite. Those serving buy and care for their own uniforms but there are other on-going expenses such as rifles, ammo, ties, gloves, rain gear, etc. They also must have transportation, which through a CCCF grant from the Judge Rick Maughmer Family Fund, helped the guard to purchase a fifteen-passenger van last year to travel to the services.

Deanna Crispen, CCCF President & CEO shared, "During the last several years, it has been my great privilege to work with the Cass County Honor Guard volunteers and more importantly to witness their service at funerals for our veterans. They need and are most deserving of our help."

# CORPORAL HUMBERTO SANCHEZ SCHOLARSHIP



**W**hen news of the tragic death of Logansport's Cpl. Humberto Sanchez reached the community in August 2021, there were many who desperately wanted to do something. Corporal Sanchez had been born and raised in Logansport and was the first in his family to serve in the U.S. Military. He was a hometown hero and as time passed and more details were shared, the family contacted the Cass County Community Foundation to start a scholarship fund to

remember Humberto each year and the sacrifice he and his family have made.

"Bert" had been an outstanding high school athlete, graduated from Logansport High School in 2017 and enlisted in the United States Marine Corps. Sanchez had served several deployments before being tasked with flying to Kabul, Afghanistan to assist in the evacuation of the U.S. Embassy, U.S. citizens, special immigrant visa applicants, and Afghans that had worked with U.S. personnel in the fight against terrorism. On August 26, 2021, Corporal Sanchez

was killed in action as he was moving civilians to safety.

Gifts to the Cpl. Humberto Sanchez Scholarship Fund have continued to come in during the time since his passing. CCCF continues to receive donations, and many are accompanied by heartfelt notes to the family. One recent note was simply signed a "combat veteran" with the words, "May Humberto's sacrifice never be forgotten."

The fund will eventually be an endowment fund and has raised over \$73,000. It is hoped to be awarded in the spring of 2023.

## ECKERT HOUSE: A 4<sup>TH</sup> DIMENSION RECOVERY HOME

After more than two years of searching and fine-tuning what was really needed, CCCF purchased the former Eckert House on Bankers Row to be eventually leased to the 4th Dimension Recovery Homes as their first zero tolerance home in Cass County.

The house, situated on the banks of the Eel River, had just the right of mix of curb appeal, green spaces, common areas and bedrooms to house the expected six to eight men who will be guests in the home. As guests, the men will be required to have full time jobs, continue in their 12 step, AA or NA meetings, and remain sober, and

contribute to the household expenses.

Opioid addiction continues to be a plague not only in the state of Indiana but specifically in rural Indiana where treatment centers and recovery opportunities are rare. The number of beds per capita are dismal and leave 98% of those who could benefit from a recovery home without access. Cass County is one of those rural counties without access. As a community, this is unacceptable, and our highest priority has been to support the establishment of a recovery home in Cass County.

Plans are to begin housing in late 2022.





## EIGHT FRIENDS SET OUT TO CHANGE THE WORLD ONE MILK CARTON AT A TIME

For a group of fifth grade girls at Pioneer Elementary, a lunchtime discussion about waste and recycling quickly developed into a project worthy of CCCF support.

The girls, working on their own time and at recesses, researched the problem and began thinking of possible local solutions. Those conversations led to the team putting together a 31-page Power-Point Presentation.

Their work was shared with Pioneer Elementary Principal Pat Quillen who was so impressed. He said, "I think what they did was amazing. They took the initiative to do this on their own, and I think that any time youth decide on an issue and take the lead on something, it's amazing." Their

teacher, Tricia Kasten, also fully supported their plan and the girls were soon scheduled to share their project with the CCCF Board on September 9, 2021.

On September 28th CCCF Board Vice Chairman, Tim Rich and CEO Deanna Crispen made a visit to Pioneer Elementary and awarded a \$200 grant for the students' recycling project, and presented them with a check to help fund their program.

"We are just so inspired by their initiative and desire to tackle something beyond themselves for the good of others," said Crispen. "Our hope is that by empowering them to chase their dream, we can help develop the next generation of community leadership.

We hope to start a program or process for all elementary schools to submit student-led ideas, research, and solutions to problems they see and care about at their schools."

After signing an agreement with the foundation, Crispen encouraged the students to attend an upcoming meeting to share what they've learned through this process. "You've set the bar high for other kids," she said, adding later that "These young ladies were articulate, poised and passionate about what they saw, what they had learned and how they wanted to fix it."

And as each nodded her head, they recited their motto in unison: "Green, blue, it's up to you. We make a difference; you can, too."



## ELEVEN NEW AED'S FOR RURAL AREAS

Our community knows all too well the shock of losing a loved-one or community member to a heart attack. In May of 2017 CCCF was able to partner with Troy Pflugner of Cardiac Science to purchase and distribute 15 new AEDs to Cass County first responder units.

The funding for those first fifteen units came from the Angelos Chogas Fund at the Cass County Community Foundation. The fund established by Mary Chogas was in memory of her father, Angelos and its sole purpose is to support the purchase of AED's.

Earlier in 2021, the Chogas Fund had once again accumulated enough resources to purchase more AED's and Cardiac Science, now part of Zoll Medical, was able to provide eleven more AED's. Nine Cass County groups participated and learned from Pflugner as

he again demonstrated and helped distribute the new AED's. He emphasized to those attending the importance of having an accessible AED and how they can save lives. During his demonstration, Pflugner also pointed out special features on the units such as the ability to be "vocally" talked through the procedure in English or Spanish and text.

In announcing the recipients, Deanna Crispen, CCCF President & CEO stated, "We have worked with Sheriff Schroder, firefighters, and our smaller communities to try and identify places that might be without the emergency availability and specifically in the rural areas."

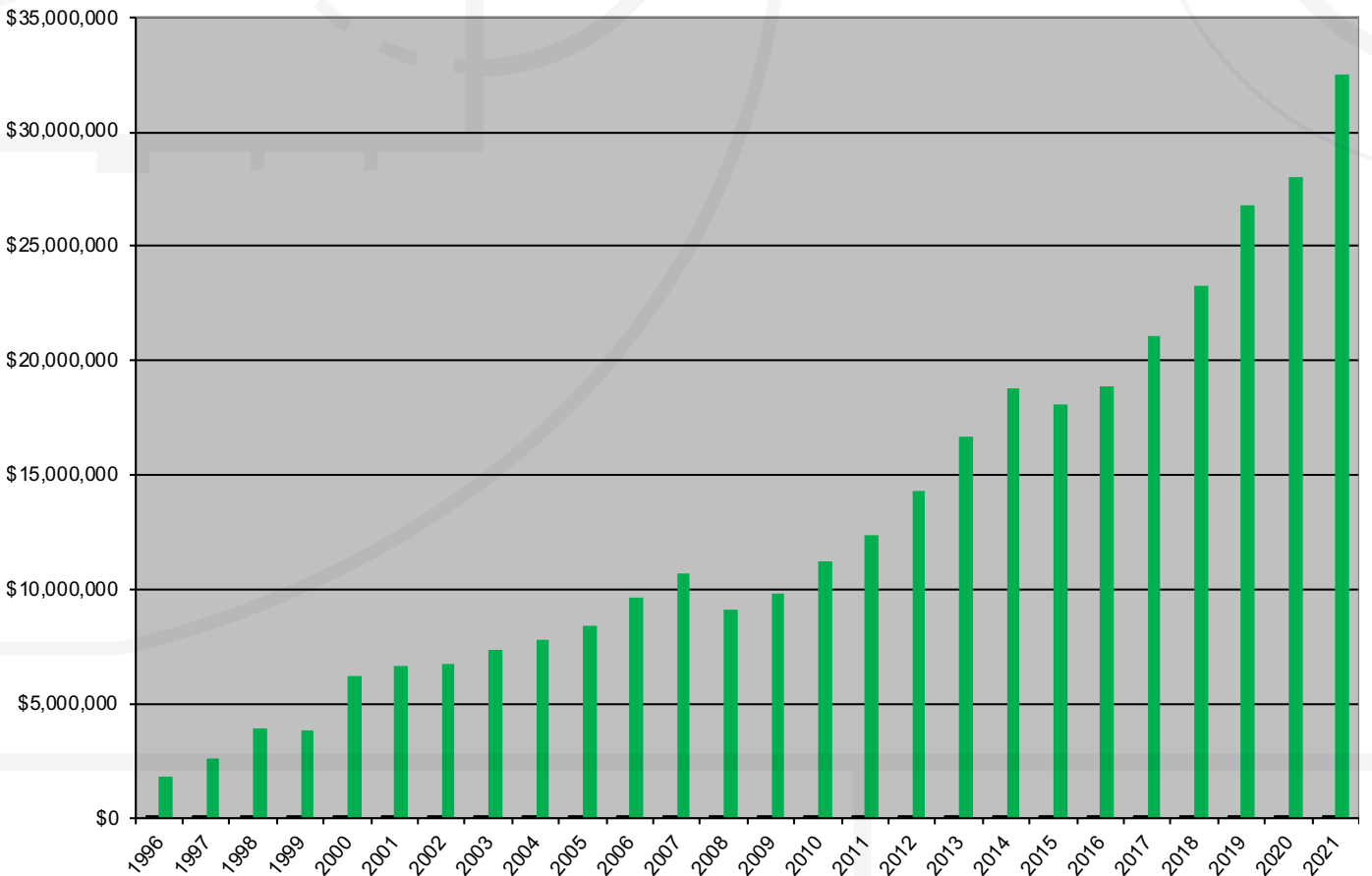

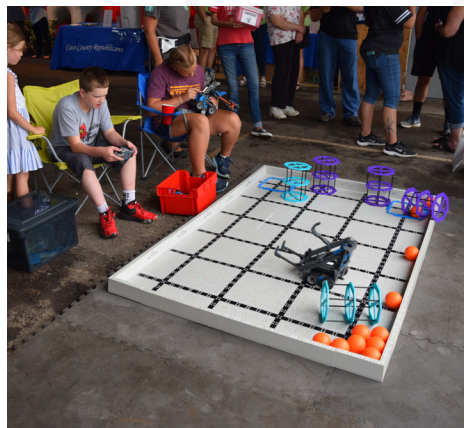

The award was established in 2001 in honor of Richard Cassidy Jr., an original CCCF board member and longtime supporter of charitable and volunteer works in Cass County. The award is not presented every year and Mitchell was only the 13th recipient since its inception.

Deanna Crispen, President & CEO of CCCF presided over

the event at the Logansport Golf Club. In introducing the evening's guest of honor, she said, "This year's award is different from all the rest because tonight, we honor a man who was not born in Indiana or the United States... he came to us from across the big pond and he still talks funny sometimes, but his heart for those who are struggling to find their way is deeper than the ocean he crossed."

Lisa Swaim, CCCF Board Chair and Bud Reed, CCCF Board Member also spoke, sharing the many contributions Jason has made to those most vulnerable in our community. As Executive Director of Emmaus, Mitchell has been an outstanding advocate for the homeless, the hungry, and those in need.

Swaim stated, "Jason is the epitome of a true servant leader, always putting the needs of those he serves first."

Not one to seek recognition, Mitchell humbly accepted the award and shared his guiding life principles as directed by the book of Romans, Chapter 12 focusing on living in harmony with one another. As a surprise, the CCCF Board also presented Mitchell with a \$5,000 grant to further the work of the mission.

## 2021 LILLY ENDOWMENT COMMUNITY SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT

**R**achel Calisto had no idea when she was called out class on a cold December morning that she would be named the Cass County Lilly Endowment Scholarship Recipient in just a few short moments. Masked, as required at the time to prevent Covid, Calisto walked into the lower level meeting room at Logansport High School to be greeted by representatives of the Cass County Community Foundation, her parents and school administrators. In presenting the traditional lily flower, Deanna Crispen, CCCF President announced that Rachel would be receiving a full tuition, four-year scholarship but also a \$900 stipend each year for required books and equipment.

Rachel, the youngest of four, is the daughter of David and Natalie Calisto. She attends IUPUI pursuing a bachelor's degree in nursing with the end goal of becoming a Nurse Practitioner. She had a 3.94 GPA on an unweighted 4.0 scale all while working an average of 27 hours per week as an essential associate at Wal-Mart.

Rachel was a member of many school organizations and held leadership positions serving as a class vice president her sophomore year and class treasurer both her junior and senior year. She was elected to Student Council all four years, is a member of National Honor Society, Key Club, Pep Club, Spanish Club and Diversity Club as well as playing tennis and participating in cross country. She has received the Distinguished Scholar Award, Academic Excellence Award, Top 20 Junior Award and 4.0 GPA Honors.

Five other finalists each received scholarships from CCCF. They are Olivia Brooke, Pioneer High School; Kynzie Bullock, Pioneer High School; Jordyn Hensley, Lewis Cass High School; Mackenzie Walker, Pioneer High School; and Nicholas Yax, Logansport High School.

Rachel is the 20th recipient from Logansport High School and the 40th Lilly Scholarship Recipient for Cass County since the program began in 1998.

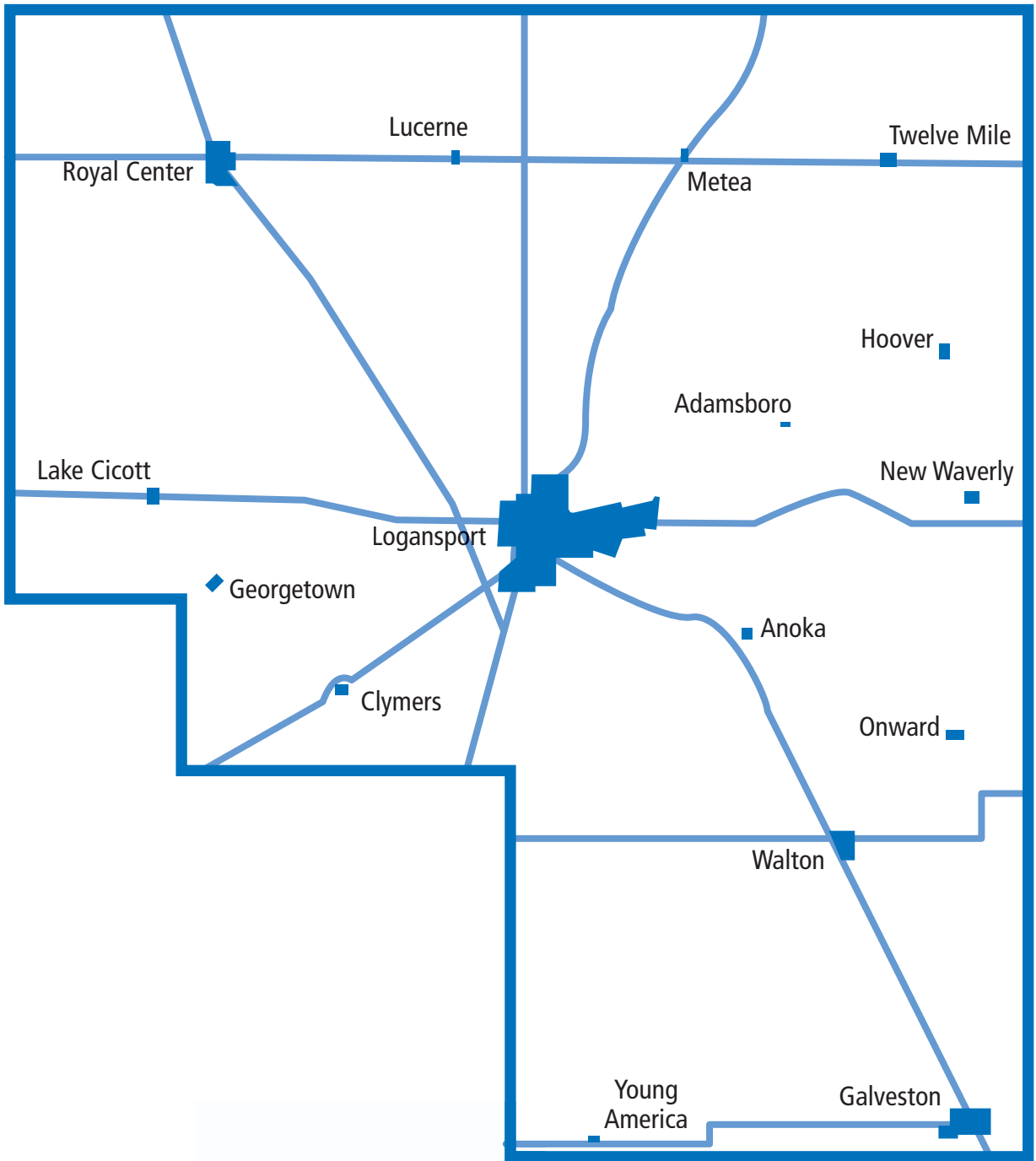
