The Cass County Community Foundation officially celebrated it's 30th anniversary on Friday, October 6, 2023 but the fun began on September 1st when the "Thirty days of Giving" surprise giveaway program spanning the entire month of September kicked off.

CCF President Deanna Crispen explained, "We are so grateful for the years of community support we have enjoyed that the Board of Directors wanted to do something to thank the community as well as feature our local businesses. The result was that for every day in September, CCCF gave away 30 of "something" to local organizations and citizens."

The Foundation highlighted local non-profits on the weekends gifting items such as 30 sports balls to the YMCA or 30 children's books to the libraries. During the week, Iron Horse Radio listeners were encouraged to call in to the local radio stations at specific times to win prizes such as 30 appetizers at Bonus Pints, bowling at Myers Sport Bowl and tickets to upcoming events.

Celebration Chairman, Tim Rich said, "we love projects like this that support local businesses, give back to the community, and allow those businesses some airtime. It's a win for everyone involved. By the time September ended, CCCF had awarded over \$50,000 in support and prizes back into the community."

he 2023 Richard Cassidy Jr. "Thanks for Giving" Award was presented to Steve Russell during the Cass County Community Foundation's 30th anniversary celebration in honor of his outstanding contributions to numerous organizations, community volunteerism, and his genuine commitment to Cass County.

The award was established in 2001 in honor of Richard Cassidy Jr., an original CCCF board member and longtime supporter of charitable and volunteer works in Cass County. The award is not presented every year and Russell was only the 14th recipient since its inception.

In making the announcement to a surprised Russell, Deanna Crispen, President & CEO said, "He never says no and was the original "git er done" guy long before Larry the Cable Guy coined the phrase. Described as a person who leads by example, she said Russell is a very hands-on leader/volunteer. His colleagues describe him as a big picture thinker but one who always makes sure all the details are covered before a project is started. He is a great communicator, always gathering input



from all members and wants every volunteer to feel appreciated. Beyond that, he even likes to have fun and is loved for his sense of humor and humble attitude. CCCF Board Member Lynn Korniak, who had served with Steve for many years at 4H said, "Steve's commitment to his community is to be admired...he leads by example."

RICHARD & ROSE GATES iscovery Award

he Gates Discovery Award was established in 2022 to assist talented high school students wishing to improve their skills through intensive summer programs. The first

award was presented to Ian Hook in spring of 2022 and allowed him to attend two summer music sessions at the renown Berkley School of Music. Hook, now a Lewis Cass graduate, said the experience was life-changing and has opened new doors of opportunity.

The awards are available to students attending Cass County high schools who have completed their freshmen year but not graduated high school and are accepted to a summer program in the field of academics or leadership.

Three students qualified in 2023 for the program. Haley Rose Logan of Caston High School attended the national student leadership conference for medicine and healthcare at the

University of Chicago, Alaina Sanchez, Lewis Cass High School attended the Joffrey School of Ballet Summer Intensive Program in Dallas, and Valerie Hinkle, Pioneer High School attended the Lutheran Summer Music Camp at Valparaiso University thanks to the Gates Award.

The Richard and Rose Gates Educational Endowment was created to help students in the community the Gates' called home. The Gates Discovery Award is only one of the opportunities created by their generosity.




Teaching Award

rittany Bertrand, a thirdgrade teacher at Lewis Cass, was surprised during a year-end convocation when she was announced as the 2023 recipient of the Elizabeth A. Billman Excellence in Teaching Award.

Deanna Crispen, CCCF President & CEO and Molly Long, CCCF Vice Chairman made the announcement and commended Bertrand for her devotion to her students, colleagues, professional development, and community. Crispen said, "Elizabeth Billman was an educator, administrator, mentor and role model for young women and teachers. When we thought about ways to honor her legacy, this award, to encourage teachers early in their careers, was the result and we know Liz would be proud we are continuing her legacy through the award."

Bertrand was nominated by her principal, who said of her, "Brittany encourages every student to put forth their very best effort and holds them accountable. She has created a space where her students are excited to learn and grow academically."

Bertrand team teaches and is responsible for third grade Science/Math/Social Studies, where her coworkers describe her as having a compassion for her students that touches



your heart and yet challenges her students to solve problems independently. She is supportive while building their own self-confidence. She utilizes the 5 E's strategy where students engage, explore, explain, extend, and evaluate.

Outside of the class room, Brittany is active in the community, the director of Camp Intervention, a STEM summer camp, and 7th grade cheerleading coach.

The excellence in teaching award was established in 2021 to honor the long legacy of Billman. Elizabeth had served faithfully on the Board of Directors of the Cass County Community Foundation for a period of 16 years, serving two terms as Chairman of the Board

of Directors and was on the Board of Directors at the time of her passing.

Mrs. Billman retired as principal at Thompson Elementary School, now known as Lewis Cass Elementary. She also taught in the Southeastern School Corporation, beginning her teaching career at Washington Township School. She was a member of the Lewis Cass Alumni Association where she received the Distinguished Service Award. Liz served in the Southeastern School Corporation for 38 years.

The award consists of a \$500 stipend for the teacher and a commemorative plaque. A permanent plaque is on display at the CCCF Office to honor each year's recipient.

SUANNE SCHWERING MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

he Suanne Schwering Memorial Scholarship was established by Columbia Middle School colleagues of Schwering after her passing in February 2023.

Schwering taught at CMS from its inception as a middle school in 1973 until her retirement in 1998. Prior to that, she taught at Daniel Webster and Washington elementary schools. She was a much loved social studies teacher and faculty member. When it came to teaching - or anything for that matter - she was all in! She made learning fun and for many of her students she was their most favorite teacher.

Beyond the classroom, she was known to build close relationships with her colleagues. She was an organizer and loved to plan numerous events and excursions with her students and cohorts. After 37 years in the classroom, Suanne decided it was time to retire but then found herself involved in "The Arts" and was the first executive director of the Cass County Arts Alliance. She also served on the Logansport Parks Board and among her



accomplishments was the inception of "Light Up Logansport" Christmas parade.

Suanne's love for her students, fellow teachers, and the community inspired her colleagues to establish this fund in her memory and honor. The scholarship is for Logansport High School seniors who plan to attend a four-year institution and major in education.

THE LEO & MARY MARGARET SCHEETZ SCHOLARSHIP

eo and Mary Margaret
Scheetz were faith-filled,
frugal, and humble. Mary
Margaret was a registered
nurse, and Leo was a farmer
all his life and proud of it.
They encouraged all their
children to attend institutions
of higher learning, and their
achievements included seven
(7) baccalaureate degrees,
three (3) master's degrees, and

one (1) Ph.D. Their educational expectations were extended to their grandchildren and great grandchildren. They believed in helping others and especially those in the local Lucerne community. This scholarship was established by their children to honor their parents' legacy of giving back and valuing education for future generations.




DR. DANIEL J. MORDENTI ENDOWMENT SCHOLARSHIP

r. Mordenti, or "Dr. M" as his students affectionately called him, was a well-known musician, educator, mentor, and life-long learner. His wife, Susan Mordenti established this scholarship after his passing in 2021 to continue his legacy, his love of music, and the importance he placed on education.

Dr. Mordenti valued his own education and worked diligently to earn the best grades possible while attending any of his classes, whether it was K-12, Bachelor's, Master's, Doctorate, or any post-graduate classes that he encountered. He believed education was the key to rising from poverty. He was also a

proponent of extracurricular involvement, because he believed these activities helped to mold students into strong community members. The award is available to students graduating from Logansport High School who exemplify the desire and drive to succeed in



college, based on one's educational performance and who are community minded.

ELIZABETH A. BILLMAN SCHOLARSHIP ENDOWMENT

teacher, principal, volunteer, community leader, advocate, and lifelong learner, Elizabeth Billman was the quintessential educator and not just in the classroom. Liz was known throughout the community for her wisdom, patience, dedication, and strong moral compass. A community foundation board member for many years, Liz led the organization with a strong conviction of the impact that the foundation could have on the community she called home. It was no surprise then, that when she passed, she had left a bequest to establish the Elizabeth A. Billman Scholarship Endowment to help future students secure an education. The award is available to students graduating from Lewis Cass High School.in the state of Indiana who plan to attend a two- or four-year college or

university.

Elizabeth loved her career as an educator and retired as principal at Thompson Elementary School, now known as Lewis Cass Elementary. She also taught in the Southeastern School Corporation, beginning her teaching career at



Washington Township School. She was a member of the Lewis Cass Alumni Association where she received the Distinguished Service Award. Liz served in the Southeastern School Corporation for 38 years.





CASS COUNTY 2023 LILLY SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT

una Tafolla, a senior at Logansport High School was awarded the 2023 Lilly Endowment Community

Scholarship for Cass County.

Luna is the daughter of Ramon and Telma Tafolla and embodies all the characteristics attributed to the annual recipients. She has selected Notre Dame University to study behavioral neuroscience with a minor in psychology. Her long-term plans include a career as a neurologist and more importantly to eventually serve as a role model for young women pursuing careers in STEM. She currently has a 4.0 GPA on an unweighted 4.0 scale all while volunteering in the community and numerous extracurricular activities and leadership positions.

Luna was selected from a pool of twenty-seven candidates and is a member of many school organizations and active in Speech, Art, and All Saints Catholic Church where she serves as an Acolyte, Lecturer, and Altar Server. She has served as Class Vice President, Diversity Club President, Spanish Club President, and Speech Team Co-Captain. A National Speech & Debate Association Academic All-American, Luna has qualified for the state speech tournament three times, is a member of LHS National Honor Society, the Outstanding Art Student at LHS Award and the Logansport Art Association's "Best of Show Award, 2022."

Luna is the 22nd recipient from Logansport High School and the 42nd Lilly Scholarship Recipient for







Cass County since the program began in 1998.

The scholarship provides for full tuition, required fees and a special allocation of up to \$900 per year for required books and required equipment for four years. The scholarship is for undergraduate students studying on a full-time basis leading to a baccalaureate degree at any eligible Indiana public or private nonprofit college or university.


